Le Navet Bete, are an award winning, internationally touring troupe of clowns based in Exeter, Devon, whose high energy, spectacular and hilarious shows have wowed audiences globally, including hundreds of outdoor performances.

Using our extensive training in clowning and improvisation, including music and circus history, we have engaged audiences since 2006, garnering widespread critical acclaim en-route.

The company is made up of five of us and we met whilst studying Theatre & Performance at the University of Plymouth. When we graduated we decided to form our own clowning theatre company and started out as five, slightly naive friends, all with an ambition to create crazy, exciting and surreal shows.

We began our relationship with the Barbican Theatre as a fledgling company via the In the Flesh Festival for new work 7 years ago. Since then the Barbican has continued to support our work and the development of the company.

Eight years later we're now an Arts Council England supported and internationally touring recognised theatre company focused on creating totally accessible contemporary performance for everyone to enjoy.

Starting out performing our work solely in theatres, as Le Navet Bete has grown, we've expanded our reach to include street theatre, festivals, corporate events and the education sector. We have also toured internationally before with extensive tours of Europe and Mexico as well as working throughout the UK.

The future! We are really thrilled to tell you that we have received Arts Council Funding to create and tour our new show, Dick Tracy. The show will launch in April and will be in Plymouth at the Barbican from April 8th-11th 2015.

The show will be based on the famous American comic book detective and is set to go out on a 45 date national tour. We can't wait to get stuck into that one.
